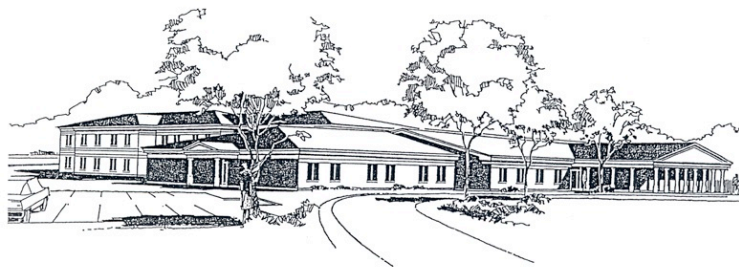

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We began the 2010/2011 school year with approximately 289 students. What a first day with the heat and everything that's new we still had a great time. We will do everything possible to create a smooth and comfortable beginning of the school year for all students. The first few weeks of school are sometimes demanding for students as they adjust to a new daily schedule. They need time to readjust to the work, the routines and to new faces. If you see things that concern you or that you have questions about, please be sure to contact your child's teacher. If I can be of any assistance, please don't hesitate to contact me here at the school.

I would like to take a moment of your time to explain the procedure for bringing your child to school or coming to get your child from school. Mornings and right after school is a very hectic time for both the students and the teachers. We would ask that you drop off your child at the front desk and they will be sent to their classroom. After school you can ask the secretary to call the room for your child to be sent down if you need to pick them up earlier. If you would like to speak to the classroom teacher, you will need to contact them first to make an appointment. They will not have the time to speak with you and take care of their students at the same time. Sorry if this is an inconvenience, however, our first priorities are the students.

Also, parents and/or guardians, remember that when you drop off your child that they should be let off at the end of the sidewalk or in the parking lot. The bus lane cannot be used during school hours: 7:30-3:15. Thank you for understanding.
