

STUDY HALL EXPECTATIONS & PROCEDURES

(Students are not to disrupt other students from learning)

EXPECTATIONS:

👍 **KEEP QUIET:** Work as quietly as possible. Most people concentrate better in a quiet environment.

👍 **COME PREPARED:** Students will arrive to class with ALL the materials they need and enough work to keep them busy for the entire class time. Students without any work will be encouraged to grab a book on my shelves and read; otherwise work may be given to them to do. Locker, water, and bathroom trips during study hall should be avoided.

👍 **LIBRARY:** Trips to the library to do work require a pre-written pass from a teacher. Laptops are not allowed in the library. I will issue one pass at a time for the library to take out or return books.

👍 **STAY SEATED:** Students are to remain at their seats. Working in groups will be at my discretion determined on an individual need basis only.

👍 **LAPTOPS:** Acceptable laptop use during study hall includes: homework, math practice, French practice, and nothing else. Games of any kind and random surfing are not allowed in study hall. Students wishing to research a topic may do so with my approval.

PROCEDURES:

1. Students will enter the classroom and go immediately to their seats while attendance is being taken.
2. I will then ask if anyone has any passes and those will be excused.
3. If you don't have any pass to leave the classroom, then you are to begin work immediately.
4. Passes and special requests should be taken care of right away to allow uninterrupted work time.

Consequences for not following the above expectations and procedures are as follows:

- 1st offense – Warning
- 2nd offense – 10 minutes after school
- 3rd offense – 20 minutes after school
- 4th offense – Visit with Vice Principal
