

## SAT READING PREP

### Syllabus

#### Semester course

This course will familiarize students with the Critical Reading component of the SAT exam. Students will develop test-taking strategies, strengthen fundamental vocabulary, grammar, and reading skills as well as learn how to continue to prepare for the SAT exam after the course is completed. Although this is an open enrollment elective, administrative may based on poor PSAT and NWEA scores and student need determine placement.

Use of online SAT Prep course to ascertain and assess student's reading skills. Students will work through each online module. Students will strive to improve their reading skills.

#### Strategies and methods:

#### SSR

Reading aloud using novels assigned in English class or any other subject area.

Articles of the week—annotation and discussion

Teach discrete reading skills such as, inference, summarization, skimming for information, finding the main idea, reading informative articles, context clues, etc.

Test taking strategies

Partner reading

Study of SAT vocabulary lists

Study of word etymologies and word families

Increasing reading speed and fluency
